OPERE

Dell'artista al momento sono note soltanto i "Tobacco Capitals" realizzati per il Campidoglio nel 1818: "Cousin of Carlo and Giuseppe Franzoni (see entries); came to the United States in 1816 to work on the U.S. Capitol. After the death of Giovanni Andrei (see entry) in 1824, Iardella succeeded to his position in charge of sculpture work on the Capitol".
